

CLUB FACILITIES



We opened our brand new three storey clubhouse complex, designed as a world class sailing facility, back in October 2015.

Downstairs is our main office and a large Junior ounge including plenty of space to lounge on couches or have a hit of table tennis. If you're looking for a hot shower you will also find our expansive changing rooms and toilet facilities in this area.

On the first floor is our spacious Southern Waters Room that will serve as a function facility on Wednesday and Sunday and a kiosk and bistro every day during the regatta. Surrounding this room on the deck are temporary 'wet area' marquees with heaters allowing you to eat your lunch or drink your hot chocolate protected from the elements but still able to view the racing area. There are also 'dry' toilets located on this level and our Racing ounge which has relaxing couches and a fire place for you to enjoy.

Upstairs is our race control room, sailing offices and the Commodores lounge. This will also double as the location of the Regatta Office and protest room.

RACING FORMAT

QUALIFYING SERIES AND FINAL SERIES

Please note that the changes to the NOR and the sailing Instructions, take precedence.

Qualifying Series

- All teams will participate in a Swiss League.
- As many rounds as possible of the Swiss League will be raced. Incomplete rounds will not be scored.
- Teams shall be ranked in the order determined by Swiss League. This changes RRS D4.

Final Series

- It is intended to race a knock-out stage finals format with the top 8 ranked teams from the qualifying series.
- Should the leading all-female team qualify for the semi-finals they will be the 1st placed all female team. If not the case, it is intended to race an all-female final coincident with the finals of the regatta.

The Race Committee may change the format, terminate any series or stage or the event. Early stages may be terminated in favour of later stages.

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

EMERGENCY SERVICES: DIAL 000

Radio

All emergency communication through VHF ch73

Incident Manager

Liam Edleston contactable via radio to BYS tower or 0412 260 243

If emergency services are likely required – call immediately & directly then notify incident manager as soon as possible.

The Incident Manager will:

- Ensure that appropriate emergency services have been notified
- Send the nominated 'First Aider' to the scene if required
- Initiate an appropriate action plan in accordance with the emergency response procedures and control entry into the affected area(s)
- Nominate someone to meet ambulance, fire or police officers to guide them to the most appropriate entry to the premises.
- Brief the emergency services upon their arrival, on the type, scope and location of the emergency.
